Introduction

Career Life Education looks at how successful career and education paths require planning, evaluating, and adapting, and how your decisions regarding career planning will be influenced by internal and external factors including local and global trends. This course is relevant to all students and covers a wide variety of topics. The focus of this course is exploring yourself and careers.
