



Food Truck 12

(Specialized Studies in Food 12 and Entrepreneurship 12)

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Introduction

This is a “two-in-one” course that is built around the concept of creating a Food Truck business. You will design your truck, menu and food, and business plan.

Upon completion, students will receive 8 Grade 12 credits from Entrepreneurship 12 (4 credits) and Specialized Studies in Food 12 (4 credits).

Course setup:

The course is set up in "week" to help guide your time in the course. You are not bound to the weeks and can move faster or slower if needed. If you plan on taking longer than a semester (four months or so), please let me know.

Your mark is based on participation in discussions (online) and assignments.

Assignments and lessons will include:

- ✓ Entrepreneurship and business basics
- ✓ Design Thinking Introduction
- ✓ Surveys to do among friends/family
- ✓ An interview with a food truck owner
- ✓ Menu building and design
- ✓ Designing your Food truck inside and out (using online design programs)
- ✓ Listing all equipment needed
- ✓ Safety (food and worker)
- ✓ Investigating permits and licenses required
- ✓ Creating a basic business plan
- ✓ Preparing your menu items and photographing your results

Assessment

Grades will be calculated according to the following weightings.

Important Course Expectations

- Students should expect to devote at minimum, 8 hours per week to this course. (This is 2 courses)
- There are a number of interview/survey assignments that will require reaching out to the community
- Students should expect to do independent research as directed.
- As this course is new, ongoing modifications to the course may be made. Major changes will be communicated.
- Students MUST be active in course work weekly. Any cause for delays must be communicated to your teacher.

Completion Timeline Expectations

This course is designed to take 16-18 weeks. It is designed to be completed within a semester but can be completed sooner, or extended longer with communication with your teacher.
