Introduction

Spanish 10 is intended to help students develop listening, speaking, reading and writing competencies at the Spanish 10 level. Pre-requisite to this course is 60% or higher in Spanish 9.

This course will allow you to learn new vocabulary, grammar and culture while experiencing them through reading, listening and speaking to gain confidence, knowledge and experience to communicate your ideas, needs and wants when in a Spanish speaking place

The course consists of 4 main themes, 2 chapters each theme for a total of 8 chapters

Capitulo 5A & 5B: Fiesta en familia	
Capitulo 6A & 6B: La casa	
Capitulo 7A & 7B: Experiencias

This course takes approximately 8-16 weeks to complete. One chapter per week finishes course in 8 weeks. The pace of this course is approximately one chapter every 1-2 weeks, plan your time accordingly.

Assessment

- Workbook (mas practica) Must show evidence of self marked, corrected, and submitted These can be printed from online text or a purchased for \$12.
- Online Actividades: There are approximately 20 per chapter. For hablar, leave voice message, send audio file, or stop by and do orally with teacher
- Unit Test and / or Theme Project

It is important to note that to become **ACTIVE** in Spanish 10 you must complete the Review (Para Empezar) online activities and workbook pages. Active status should be achieved within three weeks of signing up for the course.

- 1. Retrieve, process, and adapt information from Spanish-language resources to complete meaningful tasks.
- 2. Explain in detail acquired information in oral, visual, and written forms.

Spanish 10: Instructions:

Instructions:

1. Enter generic login & password at www.pearsonsuccessnet.com

login: 10islandconnected **password:** spanish10

- 2. Familiarize yourself with how chapters and buttons work in the I-text. You will be starting on chapter 5a.
- 3. When you are comfortable starting, click on chapter "5a: Una fiesta de cumpleanos".
- 4. Click, listen and say the **vocabulary** found at the end of the chapter in section called "Repaso del Capitulo" so you are familiar with which words are expected and how to say them properly. Be sure to create a study system for this and every chapter's vocab: flashcards, list, study booklet
- 5. You will be responsible for **working your way through the textbook** activities, in order. For each chapter, you will complete:
 - a. 9 Workbook pages, called "mas practica" online
 - b. 15-20 Online Text "Actividades" (all but the ones that require you to speak). The first chapter only has 14
 - c. Project or Unit Test for every 2 chapters
- 6. Go through your online text, in order, starting on chapter 5a, doing the "mas practica" workbook pages and "actividades" as you see them.
- 7. When finished an online "Actividad", push "PrntScrn" button and then click paste in a word document. Keep all of your "prnt scrn" work for that chapter in the same word document, email or print once the chapter is finished, and hand in. You will only need to do this when using generic login. Once you have your own personal login, these are saved and shared with me when you click, "Show Test Results". Be sure to click on "show test results"!
- 8. For the "hablar" activities, please phone our office and leave a voice mail of your Spanish speaking by first stating your name, Spanish course level, chapter, and actividad number.
- **9.** When successfully nearing completion of a chapter, be sure to study, do online test practice, review & submit work for marking. Then, come in to Island ConnectEd and write your **unit test** (or one can be emailed to a supervising teacher or teacher assistant upon request one week in advance to writing).

Weekly Plan:

- o Read, study, test self with vocab for that chapter using Study Booklet and maybe "Repaso del Capitulo" section inside online course to hear the words
- Work through i-text as you complete workbook pages (mas practica 9 pages per chapter) & actividades (15-20 actividades per chapter). Mark then correct all workbook pages.
- o prnt scrn (print screen) & paste actividades into a word document if you are using generic login. If you are using your own, click See Test Results
- o ask questions: meet teacher in person, online, or on phone
- o hand in all your work, in order, to be marked (to Learn@Home teacher at your school, fax, email, scan, at Learn@Home (tower behind NDSS)
- o write unit test (teacher supervised at your school or at Learn@Home) Email teacher 1 week in advance. Or, you may choose to do a project, found at the end of each chapter, called "presentacion"
